Provision for home learning when a child must self isolate and not attend school



Hard copies of learning resources and reading books

Once we become aware that children need to self isolate from school, we will develop hard copy learning packs as quickly as possible for adults to collect from school and use at home. These learning packs will aim to support children to practice essential key skills and review prior learning. We will also endeavour to send a selection of reading books home too.

Online learning menus

We have developed a menu of lessons and learning activities for each year group which directs children to quality learning platforms online, such as Oak Academy.

These menus are designed to give children 2 weeks worth of lessons.

Live online short lessons

Each child has access to a Google Classroom for their year group (logging in details available from school). By accessing the Google Classroom, children are able to interact with a teacher from school. At specific times of the day, a teacher will deliver short online lessons with a particular focus on practicing key skills in maths, phonics and writing as well as delivery a live story session.
