<p>Our Sport Premium initiatives for 2018/19 have included supporting children to achieve their full potential and improve readiness to learn by developing healthy bodies and minds; alongside raising the profile of physical activity across school through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improving the profile of PE and develop a greater understanding of what leading a healthy lifestyle means • Offering our children, the opportunity to participate in sports outside of the normal curriculum e.g. Hip Hop and Bhangra Dance • Continuing to provide opportunities for children to represent Warley Road in sport festivals and competitions • Supporting the whole school development of PE through training and modelling of best practice e.g. increasing lunchtime staff skills, development of teaching staff expertise • Providing additional opportunities to engage children in a lifetime love of sport and fitness • Lunchtime staff trained and successfully engaging with the children and encouraging children to engage in more active activities • Reduction in number of lunchtime incidents as the children are active and engaged

2019/20 Summary

Our Sport Premium initiatives for 2019/20 will have a primary focus on **developing children’s swimming skills to promote the enjoyment of and importance of swimming as a life skill and to ensure that a higher percentage of children pass the National Curriculum Swimming Award in 2019/20.**

To do this we will:

- Employ a qualified full-time swimming teacher to provide ability-based lessons to KS2 children and other KS1 children
- Offer vulnerable and SEND children small group/1:1 swimming session in school hours/outside of regular school hours
- Develop outcomes for children through employing a positive male role model
- Promote Warley Road as a centre of excellence for swimming in the local and wider community- encouraging children to partake in extra curricular swimming lessons.
