

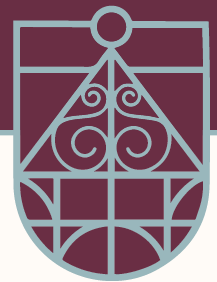

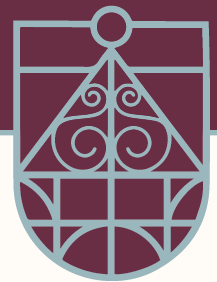

On Friday, children will share their work in the PROUD assembly where they will receive their certificate.

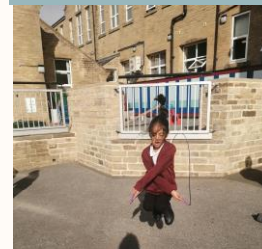
You will know we are PROUD of your children because they will bring a postcard home to tell you!



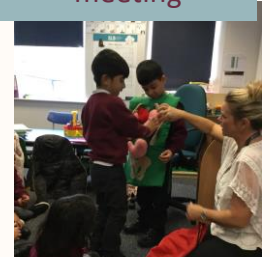
