The report shows whether your child is working within the national standards for their age, above or below. You will also see that teachers have given a coloured star (bronze, silver, gold) to show the progress your child has made and their efforts towards developing the 4 Rs.

Your child's attendance is shown as this is incredibly important in their education. A green attendance record (over 96% attendance) means your child has the opportunity to reach their full potential. Finally, you can see who your child's teacher will be next year.
